- Central Archive of multimedia containing
  - Content created by staff/students
  - Free to air recordings
  - Any video with a licence to view via a video/audio streaming service
- Available for view via College intranet interface
- Note copywrite issues

# Why use it?


- Adds contextualised visual & audio material to sessions
- Can cater for different learning styles
- Can be used to add interactivity
- Students can access outside class


